## — The King Who Comes in Peace and Blood

As Elaine shared, this is the prophecy Jesus consciously embodies—not as an unexpected twist, but as a deliberate royal claim. He rides the donkey as David and Solomon did, stepping fully into the lineage of the messianic king. In this act, the tension of the week begins to gather: humility on the surface, a storm of redemption already moving beneath it.

As April unfolds toward Easter, this passage becomes a lens for the whole story. The King who enters Jerusalem in humility is the same King who will pour out his life, descend into death, and rise again in unbreakable peace. Let this month draw you into that rhythm: the courage to face what must die, the trust to walk through the shadows, and the hope that resurrection is not an idea but a reality breaking into the world. The Messiah knows exactly who he is—and in his death and rising, he reveals who you are becoming too. [Zechariah 9:9–12](#)

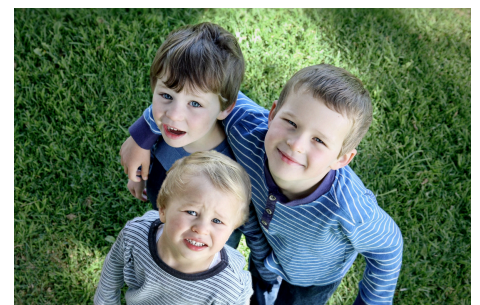
